

MDI SAR: Search and Rescue Missions

The majority of MDI SAR missions are in response to requests for assistance from Acadia National Park and the Maine Warden Service.

Date	Mission	Description
Oct 15, 2022	Rescue	A hiker on Sargent Mountain called 911 reporting they were lost off the trail after dark. Park rangers and team members reached the subject and assisted them down to the road.
Oct 11, 2022	Rescue	A female hiker suffered an ankle injury neat the top of the Beehive. She was carried in a litter down the back side of Beehive using a long belay on the top steep section of the trail, then on down to the to the road.
Sep 28, 2022	Rescue	A male hiker suffered an ankle injury neat the summit of Gorham Mountain. Patient was carried in a litter down to the parking area.
Sep 25, 2022	Rescue	A park visitor fell on the rocks near Thunder Hole suffering a head injury. The patient was moved to a litter and carried to the road and loaded into an ambulance, then subsequently transferred to the Life Flight helicopter.
Sep 15, 2022	Rescue	A 67 year old male suffered a hip injury near the summit of Champlain Mountain. He was carried down in a litter requiring one or more rope belays.
Sep 8, 2022	Rescue	A male hiker on the Cadillac West Face Trail suffered a leg injury near sunset. Trail conditions were wet and slippery. The patient was evacuated in a litter requiring multiple belays and a steep angle lower the rock slab sections of this trail.
Sep 8, 2022	Rescue	A 60 year old male suffered a knee injury at the top of the Gorge Trail. The patient was able to walk out with assistance wearing a harness and supported by rescuers.
Aug 25, 2022	Rescue	A hiker on the Gorge Trail suffered a leg injury and could not walk. They were carried in a litter down the trail to the road.
Aug 24, 2022	Rescue	A 30 year old female slipped on wet rock on the lower Beehive Trail near the auto road suffering a lower leg injury. She was carried in a litter to the road.
Aug 21, 2022	Rescue	A 78 year old male on the Cadillac Mountain North Ridge Trail was dizzy and could not stand or walk. He was packaged for transport in a litter and carried to a location where the trail is near the summit auto road. He was transferred to an ambulance at the road.

Aug 19, 2022	Rescue	A 66 year old female suffered an ankle injury on the Homans Path near the intersection with the Emery Path. The patient was packaged for transport in a litter. She was carried down the Emery Path to an ambulance at the parking area.
July 11, 2022	Rescue	A 21 year old female fell from the cliffs near Thunder Hole and suffered back injuries. A vertical raise system was constructed above the patient location. The patient was loaded and packaged by a rescuer into a litter at the bottom of the cliffs. The litter and attendant were raised to the top of the cliffs and the litter was carried to the road where the patient was transferred to an ambulance.
Jun 27, 2022	Rescue	A female hiker fell and suffered an ankle injury on the shoreline along the Great Head Trail. A litter carry was used to transport her on the trail to an ambulance in the parking lot. Heavy rain and slippery trail conditions made the rescue more difficult.
Jun 22, 2022	Rescue	A 39 year old female fell on the Cadillac West Face Trail. She had lost and regained consciousness. She was evacuated in a litter going up the trail to the auto road near the summit. A steep angle raise system was used on a section of sloping ledge. A belay was used further up the trail.
Jun 10, 2022	Rescue	A 36 year old female suffered an injury on the Bowl Trail at the intersection with the Beehive Trail. She was carried in a litter down to the auto road.
May 12, 2022	Rescue	A 45 year old female fell from 10 to 30 feet off the cliff section of the Beehive Trail. She had lost consciousness for a while. She was packaged in a litter in preparation for a short haul helicopter evacuation. When the helicopter arrived, the patient needed to be moved to a location where the helicopter crew could attach to the patient litter. She was air-lifted to a location in Bar Harbor, then transferred to a Life Flight helicopter.
Apr 4, 2022	Rescue	A hiker suffered a badly broken ankle about half way up the Beech Cliffs Trail. Multiple technical rope operations were required to carry the patient in a litter down to the Echo Lake parking area under dark and icy conditions.
Jan 23, 2022	Rescue	A hiker became stranded on ice on the Parkman Mountain South Ridge Trail. There was no injury. The rescue team responded with crampons and headlamps to assist the hiker down the trail under dark and icy conditions.
Nov 2, 2021	Rescue	An 85 year old female suffered a knee injury on the Pemetic South Ridge Trail. A litter carry was required.

Oct 17, 2021	Rescue	A 35 year old female suffered an ankle injury on Parkman Mounter under wet trail conditions. She was carried in a litter down the South Ridge Trail to the carriage road.
Oct 14, 2021	Search	A 72 year old hiker was reported overdue. She was last seen on South Bubble. Several hasty searches were performed in the South Bubble and Jordan Pond areas. Warden Service search dogs were brought in and the ground search was suspended. The subject was found about 2 hours later and was able to walk out with assistance.
Oct 12, 2021	Rescue	An 80 year old male suffered a leg injury on Bernard Mountain approximately half way up the Western Ledge Trail from Mill Field. He was carried in a litter down to the Mill Field parking area.
Sep 23, 2021	Rescue	A 60 year old female suffered a knee injury on Acadia Mountain near the summit. She was carried in a litter down the west side of the mountain. Multiple belays were used. A steep angle lower was used to bypass the stone steps near the bottom.
Aug 24, 2021	Rescue	A 58 year old female suffered a possible broken ankle on the Beech Cliffs trail. She was carried in a litter to the parking area.
Aug 21, 2021	Rescue	A 60 year old female broke her leg hiking on the Valley Cove Trail. She was placed in a litter and carried down trail to the fire road, where she was transferred to a truck and driven to the public road.
Aug 20, 2021	Rescue	A 70 year old male suffered a head and wrist injury on the Pemetic Mountain Northwest Trail. He was carried down in a litter. Multiple litter belays were required.
Aug 14, 2021	Rescue	A 70 year old female suffered an ankle injury on the North Ridge of the South Bubble. She was carried in a litter to the parking area.
Aug 13, 2021	Rescue	A 6 year old boy suffered possible serious injuries on the Cannon Brook Trail. A helicopter rescue was requested. The patient was moved in a litter down the canyon to a location accessible by the helicopter. He was evacuated to a location in Bar Harbor, then transported by Life Flight helicopter to a higher level medical facility.
Aug 12, 2021	Rescue	A 35 year old female had a seizure and lost consciousness near the summit of Gorham Mountain. She was carried in a litter down to the parking area.
Aug 11, 2021	Rescue	A 70 year old male collapsed on the Ship Harbor Trail. A short carryout in the litter was required.

Aug 10, 2021	Rescue	A 55 year old female suffered a twisted knee on the Dorr South Ridge Trail. She was carried out in a litter to the road via the Cannon Brook Trail.
Aug 1, 2021	Rescue	A 19 year old female suffered a broken ankle on the Acadia Mountain Trail above the stone steps on the west side. The patient was carried out in a litter. A belay was used on a steep rock slab. The steps were bypassed by using a steep angle lower system.
Jul 20, 2021	Rescue	A hiker suffered a broken ankle on the Beech Mountain South Ridge Trail near the summit. Thunderstorms where threatening. The patient was carried in a litter down the trail and then on the Valley Trail to avoid exposure to lightning above tree line.
Jul 16, 2021	Rescue	A 56 year old female suffered an ankle injury on the Parkman Mountain Trail. As the rescuers arrived on scene, severe thunderstorms entered the area. The patient was carried in a litter down the South Ridge Trail. A vertical lower was required over a ladder rung. Multiple belays were required in other locations.
Jul 10, 2021	Rescue	A hiker suffered a leg injury on the Acadia Mountain Trail up from the fire road. They were carried in a litter to the road and transported in a truck to the public road.
Jul 7, 2021	Rescue	A female hiker apparently broke an ankle on the South Bubble South Ridge Trail. This trail is extremely steep. Park rangers with medical gear and a boot hiked up to the patient and made the decision to walk out. The recue team stood by with a litter and technical rope rescue gear. Before reaching the bottom, the patient was in increasing pain the plan switched to a litter carry. Multiple belays were used on the very steep trail. The patient was transferred to a small boat and transported across Jordan Pond to the parking area.
Jun 28, 2021	Rescue	A 53 year old female reportedly lost consciousness while hiking on the Dorr Mountain Ladder Trail. Bar Harbor medics arrived on scene and administered IV fluids. MDISAR was on the scene and remained on stand by as the patient and medics walked out.
Jun 3, 2021	Rescue	A female hiker suffered an ankle injury on the Bubbles Divide Trail. A litter carryout was called, but the patient was able to walk out with assistance.
May 29, 2021	Rescue	A 35 year old female dislocated a knee near the intersection of the Beehive and Bowl trails. She was carried in a litter to the road.
May 25, 2021	Rescue	A 60 year old female suffered a broken ankle while hiking on the lower Beehive Trail. She was carried in a litter to the road.

May 22, 2021	Rescue	A female hiker suffered an ankle injury on the Cadillac South Ridge Trail between Eagle Crag and Cannon Brook. A litter carry was used to transport her to the road.
May 15, 2021	Rescue	A 22 year old female hiker on the Cadillac South Ridge Trail in the vicinity of Blackwoods Campground suffered a hip injury. She was carried in a litter to the campground.
Apr 24, 2021	Rescue	The team was called to assist with the rescue of a 47 year old female from the top of Black Mountain in Sullivan. By the time team members arrived on scene, rescuers from local fire departments had met the subject and were walking her out.
Mar 19, 2021	Search	The team was called to assist park rangers in the search for a missing couple who had not checked out of their hotel the day before.
Mar 13, 2021	Rescue	A 27 year old male had fallen or collapsed on the Sargent Mountain South Ridge Trail. He regained consciousness after a few minutes. He was packaged in a litter for stability and warmth and was carried to the carriage road. The road was too icy for vehicle access so the patient was carried out to the parking lot.
Mar 3, 2021	Rescue	A report was received for an individual who had fallen from the Precipice Trail. The subject was located in a narrow crevice off the bottom portion of the trail. A technical rope rescue was needed to get him back on the trail. Conditions were treacherous and icy. A rescue helicopter was requested from the Army National Guard. The helicopter rescue crew were lowered to the subject and were able to raise him to the aircraft for evacuation to Bar Harbor.
Dec 13, 2020	Rescue	A young female hiker suffered an ankle injury in the vicinity of Cedar Swamp Mountain. She had a history of low tolerance to pain. She attempted to walk out with assistance, but passed out. A litter carry was called for. By the time the rescue team arrived, she had walked to the parking area.
Nov 1, 2020	Search	The team was called to assist in the search for a middle-aged man missing for about a week in Enfield, Maine.
Oct 25, 2020	Rescue	A 40 year old male slipped on wet leaves on the Champlain North Ridge Trail. He was carried in a litter to the road.
Oct 19, 2020	Search	The team was called to assist in the search for a missing woman in the Donnel Pond area of Sullivan. The subject planned to go on a short hike but failed to return to her camp site. Her husband contacted the Warden Service. A search was called for the next

morning. The subject was found the next morning on a public road after walking about 10 miles and spending the night in the woods.

Oct 15, 2020	Rescue	A 50 year old female suffered an ankle injury on the Cadillac Cliffs Trail at the cave. She was carried out in a litter. Multiple "caterpillar" passes were required in, around, and through the many boulders on this trail.
Oct 9, 2020	Rescue	A 62 year old female suffered an ankle injury at the summit of Champlain Mountain. She was carried in a litter down the north ridge trail. A litter belay was used on one steep section of the trail.
Oct 6, 2020	Rescue	An 82 year old male sustains a head laceration and shoulder injury on the Great Head Trail. He was able to walk out with assistance but the team accompanied the walk out in case a litter carry was needed.
Sep 27, 2020	Rescue	A male hiker with a leg injury required a litter carryout from Beech Mountain on the northwest side trail.
Sep 16, 2020	Recuse	A report of a 60 year old female having collapsed on the Jordan Cliffs Trail was received. Rangers administered oxygen and stabilized the patient. MIDSAR was put on stand by. The patient walked out with assistance and was transferred to an ambulance.
Sep 5, 2020	Rescue	A female hiker suffered an ankle injury mid-way up the Cadillac North Ridge Trail. She was packaged in a litter and carried up the trail to a location where the auto road is near the trail, where she was transferred to an ambulance.
Sep 4, 2020	Rescue	A 15 year old female suffered an ankle injury near the intersection of the Bowl and Beehive trails. She was carried in a litter to the road.
Sep 3, 2020	Rescue	A female hiker suffered a leg injury near the top of Parkman Mountain. She was packaged in a litter and carried down the North Ridge Trail to an ambulance waiting on the carriage road.
Aug 15, 2020	Rescue	A call came in for a technical rescue for a person who fell along Ocean Path near Thunder Hole. She had scrambled down the cliffs to walk on rocks at low tide. She slipped and fell 8 feet injuring her ankle. A rope system was built to lower an attendant to her. She was placed in a harness and rescued with a pick off technique. She was then carried in a litter to the road.
Aug 13, 2020	Rescue	A solo male hiker fell off the Gorham Mountain Trail and was found in a ravine off the trail. He suffered a broken pelvis/hip and a broken arm and was disoriented. He was carried in a litter to an ambulance waiting at the trail head.

Aug 11, 2020	Rescue	A male hiker suffered a broken ankle on the Bowl Trail above the Beehive Trail intersection. He was carried in a litter to the road.
Aug 9, 2020	Rescue	A hiker fell on the Beehive Trail near the intersection with the Bowl Trail and suffered a painful leg injury. The subject was placed in a litter and carried to the road.
Aug 5, 2020	Rescue	A female hiker suffered an ankle injury on the Cadillac West Face Trail at the top near the South Ridge Trail. She was placed in a litter and carried up to the Blue Hill Overlook parking area.
Aug 2, 2020	Rescue	A 51 year old female suffered a hip injury on the Beech Mountain West Ridge Trail. A litter evacuation was required. One or more belays were required on the steep terrain.
Jul 25, 2020	Rescue	A 63 year old female suffered a head injury off trail on Pemetic Mountain near the Bubble Pond parking lot. A rope system was used to lower the patient in a litter to the trail. She was carried to the parking lot.
Jul 7, 2020	Rescue	A woman with an apparent broken ankle was carried out from the Gorham Mountain Trail where it intersects the Bowl Trail.
Jul 1, 2020	Rescue	A 37 year old female suffered a broken ankle on the Gorham Mountain Trail. A short carry was used to transport the subject in a litter to the parking lot.
Jul 1, 2020	Rescue	MDISAR was requested to assist with a litter carryout for a 54 year old female with an ankle injury. The incident happened near the intersection of the Bowl and Beehive trails.
Jun 20, 2020	Recue	A young male fell from the cliffs at the Maine Coast Heritage Trust property on Cooksey Drive. A companion was able to scramble down and pull the subject from the water onto a small ledge. A vertical raise was used to bring the subject in a litter to the top of the cliffs. He was then carried to the ambulance. A second raise was used to bring the companion up in a harness.
Apr 16, 2020	Rescue	A young female fell from the cliffs at the Maine Coast Heritage Trust property on Cooksey Drive in Seal Harbor. A 30 foot vertical raise was used to bring the subject in a litter to the top of the cliffs. She was then carried to the parking lot.
Feb 16, 2020	Rescue	A 50 year old male fell on the rocks near the water at the southern point on Great Head. The injury was a likely broken lower leg. A belay was used to carry the litter from the water's edge to the trail. The patient was then carried out to the road.

Nov 9, 2019	Rescue	A female hiking on the Breakneck Road suffered a knee injury while crossing a stream. She was carried out in a litter to Hulls Cove.
Oct 29, 2019	Rescue	A 42 year old female suffered and ankle injury on the Bowl Trail near the Beehive Trail. She was carried in a litter down the trail under wet and slippery conditions.
Sep 29, 2019	Rescue	A female hiker suffered an ankle injury on the Beech Mountain South Ridge Trail approximately half way from the summit. She was carried in a litter to the Valley Trail and then on to the Lurvey Spring Road.
Sep 11, 2019	Rescue	A female hiker on the Day Mountain Trail suffered an ankle injury. She was carried in a litter to the road.
Aug 12, 2019	Rescue	A young man fell near the top of Pemetitc Mountain from possible heat exhaustion. He was carried in a litter down the North Ridge Trail to the parking lot.
Jul 23, 2019	Search	The team was called to assist in the search for a missing 62 year old male in Greenville.
Jul 14, 2019	Rescue	A female hiker suffered an apparent fractured ankle near the intersection of the Dorr Mountain North Ridge and Hemlock trails. She was carried in a litter to the Jessup Path near Sieur du Monts and then transported by ranger vehicle.
Jul 5, 2019	Rescue	During the Cadillac West Face rescue, a report of an injury on Dorr Mountain was received and rescuers were dispatched to that incident. The subject was reported to have gone in and out of consciousness. Because of the two ongoing incidents, a helicopter rescue was requested for the Dorr Mountain incident.
Jul 5, 2019	Rescue	A male hiker slipped and fell on the Cadillac Mountain West Face Trail and suffered injuries to his ankle, heel and arm. He was placed in a litter and was transported down using multiple belay carries. A rope system was constructed for a steep angle lower over the rock slabs near the bottom of the trail. More belays were used to safely carry the litter the remaining distance to the parking lot.
Jul 1, 2019	Rescue	A man in his 70s fell from the top of the cliff to the water below at Raven's Nest on Schoodic Peninsula. The subject was rescued via Winter Harbor Fire Department boat.
Jun 24, 2019	Rescue	The team was called to assist with the rescue of a 57 year old female with a laceration to the shin. She was able to walk out with assistance.

Jun 12, 2019	Rescue	A 60 year old male suffered an ankle injury on the Norumbega North Ridge Trail. He was carried in a litter to the Hadlock Pond pump station road.
Jun 12, 2019	Rescue	A 50 year old female suffered a lower leg fracture on the Gorge Path. She was carried down the trail in a litter to the road.
May 26, 2019	Rescue	A female hiker suffered an ankle injury on the Champlain Mountain North Ridge Trail near the intersection with the Orange and Black Trail. A litter carry was required.
May 2, 2019	Search	The team was called to participate in a ground search in Hermon for a 25 year old male who was missing for 2 weeks. Team members were assigned to a grid search team and to assist a dog team.
Apr 28, 2019	Search	Team members assisted in the search in Bangor for a man missing since September 2018.
Feb 12, 2019	Rescue	A 60 year old female suffered an ankle injury near the intersection of the Gorham Mountain and Beehive trails. Ice made the carryout to the road very difficult.
Oct 14, 2018	Rescue	A female hiker suffered a broken ankle on the Beech Mountain South Ridge Trail. She was carried in a litter to the Lurvey Spring Road.
Oct 13, 2018	Search	A ground search was conducted in Blue Hill for a woman reported missing in August 2018. The search focused on an area where some items of interest were found from a previous search. Nothing of value to the search was found.
Oct 12, 2018	Rescue	A 71 year old female suffered an ankle injury on the Parkman Mountain North Ridge Trail. A short litter carry to the carriage road was performed. The patient was transferred by truck to an ambulance waiting at the public road.
Oct 7, 2018	Rescue	A young female climber fell approximately twenty feet at the northern most climbing area at Otter Cliffs. The subject was packaged in a litter and was raised vertically with a rope system. From the top of the cliffs, she was carried in the litter to an ambulance at the road.
Sep 28, 2018	Search	The team was called to assist with the search for a missing sky diver near the Lebanon, Maine airport.
Sep 15, 2018	Rescue	Two female hikers ventured off trail between Echo Lake and the Beech Mountain Loop Trail and became stranded on a ledge. There were no injuries, but darkness and fog set in. A lower/raise system

was constructed above the subjects and an attendant was lowered to the scene. Each person was raised individually with the attendant.

Sep 14, 2018	Rescue	A female fractured an ankle on the rocks beneath the Bass Harbor light house. She was evacuated up the stairs in a litter using a rope raise system.
Sep 3, 2018	Rescue	A female hiker suffered a serious leg injury on the Dorr Mountain Ladder Trail. She had a compound fracture of the lower leg with severe bleeding. The injury was due do a rock that fell on her while exploring a cave/overhang just off the trail. She was moved to an open ledge below via a steep angle operation, where she was evacuated by helicopter.
Sep 1, 2018	Rescue	A 53 year old female fell and suffered an ankle injury on the west side of Beech Mountain near the summit. Patient had recent brain and spine surgery. A litter carryout was used on the western Beech Mountain Trail to the parking lot.
Aug 5, 2018	Rescue	A 15 year old female suffered an ankle injury between the summit of Beehive and the Bowl. Subject was carried down the Beehive trail to the road.
Aug 1, 2018	Search	Report of an 83 year old female missing in Millbridge, Maine. Four members of MDISAR responded. They were assigned to do a grid search along the coast near the subject's home. She was later found alive by dog searchers.
Aug 1, 2018	Rescue	A male subject suffered a back injury on the bottom portion of Acadia Mountain. He was carried in a litter down to the fire road and was transported by truck to the ambulance at the public road.
Jul 30, 2018	Rescue	A female hiker suffered an ankle injury on the Gorham Mountain North Ridge Trail. She was placed in the litter and carried down the trail to the Beehive Trail and on to the road.
Jul 24, 2018	Rescue	A 27 year old female fell and injured her ankle while hiking the upper portion of the Champlain North Ridge Trail. The injury was splinted. She was placed in a litter and carried down to the road for transport by ambulance.
Jul 23, 2018	Rescue	A 26 year old male fell while climbing the rungs on the upper Precipice Trail. According to news accounts, he grabbed a rock to pull himself up and the rock gave way. He fell and tumbled approximately 60 feet suffering broken bones and lacerations. Fog and pending darkness prevented evacuation by helicopter. Approximately 36 people were involved starting at approximately 7

pm. Multiple belays and directional rigging were used to carry the patient and litter down the slope. Significant risk to the rescue team from falling off trail was mitigated by tying into the litter. A guiding line was set up to transport the patient down from the Orange and Black Trail to the road. The patient was transported to an ambulance at about 1 am.

Jul 11, 2018	Rescue	50 year old mail fell on Gorham Mtn north ridge trail and suffered a knee injury. Was carried out down the north ridge to the Beehive trail and to the parking area near Sand Beach.
Jul 2, 2018	Rescue	Young adult male experienced a seizure, fell, and suffered a bleeding head injury near the summit of South Bubble. Was carried out to the Bubble Rock parking area.
Jun 22, 2018	Rescue	Carryout of woman with leg injury 0.7 miles up the Gorham Mt south ridge trail.
May 11, 2018	Rescue	Young adult female suffered ankle injury on Dorr South Ridge Trail near intersection with Cannon Brook Trail. Was evacuated via litter carryout for approximately 1.5 miles to the Route 3 trail head.
Oct 28, 2017	Rescue	74 year old male fell on the rocks below Bass Harbor Light House and lost consciousness for a period. Was transported by litter up stairs to the parking lot and was transferred to Life Flight helicopter.
Oct 28, 2017	Rescue	Male hiker suffered 2 leg injuries on the lower Precipice Trail and was transported by a short litter carry to the parking lot.
Oct 12, 2017	Rescue	A hiker left the Precipice Trail and became stuck on a ledge. The team conducted a "pick off" by lowering a rescuer down to the subject on a rope system. The subject and rescuer were raised up to a location where all could walk out.
Oct 10, 2017	Rescue	Carry out for 60 year old male with head injury on lower Acadia Mtn. Subject was unable to walk and was carried out by litter.
Sep 10, 2017	Rescue	Received request from Hancock County regarding a female with broken leg on Tunk Mountain trail near Franklin Maine. The patient was rescued by Maine Forest Service helicopter. Two SAR members responded to assist family members down the trail after dark.
Sep 3, 2017	Rescue	23 year old female fell on the Cadillac West Face trail about half way up from Bubble Pond. One SAR member proceeded down the trail with the litter. The subject was able to walk and made their way up with assistance. SAR members staged at the top of the trail with equipment for a belay if needed.

Aug 20, 2017	Rescue	60 year old female suffered a shin laceration on Sargent Mtn South Ridge trail near the summit. A total of 17 persons were on scene, of which 8 were MDI SAR members. The carryout had 4 steep or slippery places where a belay was used.
Aug 11, 2017	Rescue	40 year old female fractured her ankle near the top of Penobscot Mtn. A total of 13 park and MDI SAR personnel conducted the litter carry out down Penobscot South Ridge trail to the carriage road where the patient was transferred to an ambulance.
Aug 2, 2017	Rescue	30 year old female suffered ankle injury on Cadillac Cliffs trail at Gorham Mountain. Park and MDI SAR personnel conducted carryout over difficult terrain of many large boulders.
Jun 10, 2017	Rescue	Female suffered a broken ankle near top of Acadia Mountain. Patient was transported from summit by Maine Forest Service helicopter. MDI SAR personnel assisted with preparing patient for the airlift.
